### Be aware!!

On Monday of this week the breakdown of debt (which has increased from last week) was as follows:

After School Club - £703.36
Breakfast Club - £168.44
Dinners - £1034.83
Nursery/Pre-school - £1360.90

#### Total owed to the school - £3267.53

Regardless of our constant reminders debts are not being paid as they should be.

This cannot continue.

This school cannot afford to provide services that are not being paid for.

The normal monthly reminders will go out and where the debt is not paid, and no contact is made with the school to explain, the services will be made unavailable until the debt is cleared.

We have been very lenient and given plenty of warning that we would take this approach.

If you owe the school money be prepared to be told that After school Club, Breakfast Club, Nursery provision and dinners will no longer be available until the debt is settled.

If you believe your balance is incorrect or you have issues with Parent Pay please speak to the school office.
