



What is an organism?

An **organism** is another word for a **living thing**, including plants and animals.

What is a habitat?

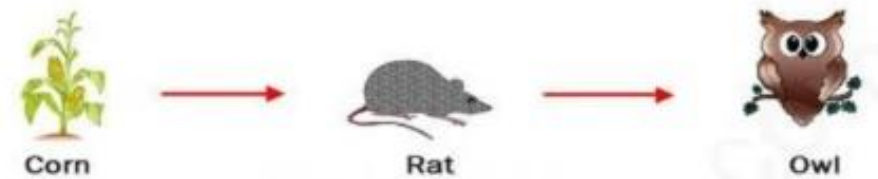
A **habitat** is a place where an **organism** lives. Some **organisms** can be found in lots of different **habitats**, while others can only **survive** in one type of **habitat**. A **habitat** must provide everything that an organism needs to **survive**, otherwise the organism will not be able to live there and will die.

What is a microhabitat?

A **microhabitat** is a very specific, small home **environment** for **plants, animals and insects** for example: **ponds, individual trees, under a stone, a pile of logs.**

Food chains

The **animals** and **plants** in any **habitat** are linked together through **food chains**. **Food chains** show what animals eat. **Energy** passes from one animal to another as they eat one another.
